Day 1: Depart Kuala Lumpur - Baku

Check-in at Kuala Lumpur International Airport for flight to Baku.

Day 2: Arrive Baku

Upon arrive at Baku, be met and greeted before being transferred your accommodation for check in. Rest of the day at leisure

Day 3: Baku – Absheron Paninsula breakfast

Today a sightseeing tour of Baku; Visit Memory Alley, medieval fortress of Old Baku, the Complex of Shirvana's Palace. Continue with a visit to the medieval market square, handmade carpet's workshop before reaching "Yanardag", Temple of the Five Worshippers.

Day 4: Baku - Gobustan - Baku breakfast

Take a tour to Gobustan and Mud Volcanoes: on this tour, you will be ferried around by jeeps. Moving on to visit the ancient art reserve of Gobustan. Study the epoch's way of life of an, with the noticeable petroglyphic paintings on the wall. On the way back, stop by the H.Aliyev center, the Flag Square and the Crystal Hall.

Day 5 : Baku – Shamakhi - Sheki breakfast

Depart towards Sheki. En route, visit Diri Baba Mausoleum located in Maraza Village. Reach Shamakhi and visit the "Friday Mosque "Juma Mosque and the mausoleum of Yeddi Gumbez. Arrive in Sheki and visit the local medieval fortress; Sheki Khan's palace and other local museums in the area. Check in to your accommodation for the evening.

Day 6: Sheki – Gremi – Alavrdi – Telavi (or Kvareli) breakfast Cross the border into Georgia and begin sightseeing in Kakheti, Georgia's famous wine district dotted with fine old churches and vineyards. Check into your accommodation at Kvareli, before heading out to visit the Gremi architectural complex, where you will notice the royal citadel and the Church of the Archangels. Continue to Alaverdi Cathedral; one of the most well-known antique temples in Georgia and Tsinandali Residence.

Day 7 : Telavi - Bodbe - Singhnaghi - Tbilisi breakfast

Today head South East to visit St. Nina's Monastery in a village called Bodbe. Continue to visit Sighnaghi a beautiful hill-town with panoramic view of the Alazni Valley and the Eastern Caucasus Mountains. Explore the town by foot with optional wine tasting. After that, continue drive and overnight at Tbilisi.

Day 8 : Tbilisi – Tbilisi City Tour breakfast

After breakfast, go on a full day tour of Tbilisi, visit the old town, Metekhi Temple, the Abanotubani, Narikala (the main fortress of Tbilisi). Continue with Sioni Cathedral, Anchiskhati Church, the Georgian National Museum and Rustaveli Avenue located on the main street of Tbilisi, head up Mt Mtatsminda by funicular for a spectacular view of the city.

Day 9: Tbilisi – Mtskheta – Goti – Uplistsikhe – Kutaisi breakfast After breakfast, start the journey with a visit to Mtskheta; the UNESCO antique capital of Georgia where Christianity was adopted by the Georgians as early as the 4th century. Continue journey to Gori, Uplistsikhe cave town and last stop at Kutaisi. Visit the UNESCO site of the Gelati Monastery, masterpiece of the Georgian Golden Age.

Day 10: Kutaisi – Prometheus Caves - Batumi breakfast
Visit Prometheus Caves; one as the prominent highlights of
Georgia. Continue towards the Black Sea coast and the town of
Batumi, which is the capital of Ajara, it serves a seaport and is home
to beautiful Botanical Gardens. Visit its major sites; old town,
Batumi Piazza, Thestrical and Neptun Squares, etc walk in Batumi
Boulevard.

Day 11 : Batumi - Bakuriani breakfast & dinner

Spend the morning at leisure at Batumi, optional for Botanical Garden. In the afternoon, drive to Bakuriani Ski resort surrounded by the Lesser Caucasus Mountains in the southern part of Georgia.

Day 12 : Bakuriani – Vardzia – Akhaltsikhe - Bakuriani breakfast & dinner

Take a drive along Kura Valley to the cave town Vardzia, along the journye, stop at Khertvisi fortress, is one of the oldest fortress in Georgia and was pracitcal throughout the Georgian medieval era. On the way back visit, Rabati"- the old part of Akhaltsikhe.

Day 13 : Bakuriani – Borjomi – Ananuri - Gudauri breakfast & Dinner

Today visit Borjomi town park, where you will have the chance to taste the natural Borjomi mineral waters. Then continue on a drive along the Georgian Military Highway where the historical road leads north into the Caucasus Mountains. The road will cut through the spectacular Ananuri fortress. Drive by the edge of the dramatic Aragvi River Valley where you will reach Gudauri ski resort (2000m).

Day 14 : Gudauri – Kazbegi - Tbilisi breakfast

With the view of the majestic mountains, Kazbegi (now official name is Stepantsminda) is a picturesque scene overlooking Mount Kazbek whicg is set a 5047m; also know as the third highest mountain in Georgia. Next, take a walk up to the Gergeti Sameba Church located on the hilltop providing splendid views of Mt. Kazbek.

Day 15 : Depart Tbilisi breakfast

Be transferred to Tbilisi International Airport for your flights.

Day 16: Arrival in Kuala Lumpur
